

## 'Focus on' Energy Saving

This half day **GrowSave workshop** provides growers with an interactive forum on the practical implementation of energy efficiency measures in **low energy protected cropping**.

A flexible programme is planned to give growers the opportunity to discuss any aspect of HDC energy related projects and will include an 'energy clinic' session where growers are encouraged to bring along particular issues for discussion.

We envisage this workshop will be of interest to nurseries producing crops such as leafy salads, chilli peppers, herbs, bedding, cut flowers, edible and ornamental propagation with typically lower temperature set points. Growers, supervisory staff and those with a specific interest in energy management systems will benefit.

FEC have been undertaking HDC funded research for over 10 years and will use this experience to lead the event in collaboration with a professional facilitator.

To provide a flavour of topics that might be covered research areas that the FEC team have contributed to include:

- Better management practice
- Improving temperature and humidity control
- Improving boiler efficiency
- Lighting systems
- Renewable technologies
