This half day **GrowSave workshop** provides growers with an interactive forum on the practical implementation of energy efficiency measures in **high temperature protected cropping**.

A flexible programme is planned to give growers the opportunity to discuss any aspect of HDC energy related projects and will include an 'energy clinic' session where growers are encouraged to bring along particular issues for discussion.

With a focus on energy intensive production, we envisage this workshop will be of interest to nurseries producing crops such as tomatoes, cucumbers, peppers, aubergines, poinsettia, begonias, orchids and pot chrysanthemums.
